



SUPPORTING FIRST RESPONDERS

Wink to Webster Pipeline LLC strives to be a good neighbor in the communities where we work and operate. To demonstrate our commitment, we are implementing a First Responder Grant Program to support training and equipment needs of responders along the Wink to Webster Pipeline route in Texas. The grant program helps first responders better serve their communities by providing additional resources that enhance their safety and training.

HOW IT WORKS

We encourage first responders in direct proximity of the Wink To Webster Pipeline to submit a brief application to introduce your organization and explain how it would use a grant. Most grant awards will range from \$2,500 to \$10,000, although some exceptions may be made. An organization is eligible to receive a grant from Wink To Webster Pipeline once.

If your organization receives a grant, the improvement project must be completed within one year of grant acceptance, unless otherwise specified. Once complete, Wink To Webster Pipeline requires an impact report to determine the effectiveness of the grant.

Grants will be awarded in the sole discretion of Wink To Webster Pipeline.

SELECTION CRITERIA

In determining eligibility for making a charitable donation, the Wink To Webster Pipeline considers the following:

- Status as a U.S. 501(c)3 organization, such as a volunteer fire department, or municipal public safety organization, engaged in emergency response activities
- Proximity to the pipeline route (~ 30 miles or less) receives priority

Note: If your grant application is selected by the committee, you will be required to sign a release that will allow Wink To Webster Pipeline to use information about the grant award in company promotional materials.

REQUESTS SHOULD DEMONSTRATE:

- A lasting, measurable impact to the community and/or requesting organization
- Direct benefit to the safety or preparedness of first responders and the surrounding community

Priority will be given to grants that help to ensure first responders are properly equipped and trained to respond to a pipeline incident

THE WINK TO WEBSTER PIPELINE FIRST RESPONDER GRANT PROGRAM IS NOT DESIGNED TO SUPPORT:

- Individuals or families
- Ongoing annual funding for an organization
- Organizations located in communities that are not within close proximity to the Wink To Webster Pipeline route
- Political, labor, fraternal organizations or civic clubs and any organization that distributes political messages or otherwise attempts to influence legislation
- Athletic or sporting event sponsorships unless directly related to supporting community public safety and emergency preparedness, and for charitable purposes

Exceptions may be made at the Wink To Webster Pipeline's sole discretion.
